DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO GLASTONBURY – Sunday 10th July

The annual Glastonbury Pilgrimage is the only public act of witness in the diocesan calendar, making it a very special occasion.

From 12noon until 3pm the Shrine church will become a chapel of Exposition and Silent Adoration, providing a quiet environment immediately opposite the Abbey Grounds.

Also from 12 noon until 3pm the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Private Healing Prayer will be offered in two separate tented chapels, erected immediately inside the Abbey gates, close to the church.

The Rosary procession will start in the Abbey Grounds at 2.15pm, and the Pilgrimage Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Declan at 3.30pm.

There is a poster and more details on the notice board, and some A5 flyers for volunteer Altar Servers. Finally, don't forget to visit St Michael's Pathway stall in the Abbey Grounds, raising funds for our parish.
